

Glenn Fox VMATYC Mathematics and Computer Science Scholarship \$800

Attention Virginia Community College Students!

The Virginia Mathematical Association of Two-Year Colleges will award a merit scholarship of \$400 per semester for the academic year 2009-2010.

CRITERIA: A SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT MUST

Intend to major in mathematics, computer science, or mathematics education and demonstrate potential for success in any of these areas. Preference will be given to those candidates who intend to teach mathematics or computer science.

Demonstrate ability, determination, and motivation necessary for successful academic performance.

Be a high school graduate or equivalent by Fall Semester 2009.

Have completed at least 12 semester hours of college-level courses, including 3 hours of transfer mathematics at a Virginia community college by the end of Spring Semester 2009 with a GPA of 3.2 or higher.

Continue for two semesters (Fall 2009 - Spring 2010) at a Virginia community college and enroll in at least 6 semester hours of college-level courses, including a transfer-level mathematics course, for each semester the scholarship is received.

PROCEDURE: A SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT MUST

- Complete the application.
- Send official transcripts of college work and three (3) letters of reference.
